MEMO: SUNSHINE COAST SCHOOL SPORT GIRLS CRICKET TRIALS

Queensland Cricket are conducting a number of girls cricket development sessions across the South East Queensland area which incorporates a number of school sport regions. They have indicated that the afternoon session for the Sunshine Coast Region will be held on <u>Tuesday 8 March 2016 (4.00 – 6.00pm) at the Sunshine Coast Grammar School.</u> These sessions are open to girls aged 10-15 years of age.

These sessions require students and their parents to submit an 'Expression of Interest' form to the convenor – Cath Sandurski <u>csandurski@stmc.qld.edu.au</u> by **Friday 4 March 2016.** It is a parent responsibility to nominate their child.

Please pass this information letter, along with the attached flyer and nomination form, to girls from your school who are interested in playing *representative cricket*.

The School Sport Office has received a number of requests regarding the viability of introducing girls cricket into its Sunshine Coast School Sport representative program. The sport office has proposed the following process for examining the prospect of introducing this sport into the SCRSS calendar for future years.

Sunshine Coast School Sport will examine the number of girls attending the girls cricket development session on Tuesday 8 March to decide whether it is a viable option for our school sport region to enter either a 10-12 years or 13-15 Years girls cricket team in the state championships in **2017 and beyond**.

In the current school sport calendar, a number of other regions participate in a 10-12 Years Girls Cricket State Championships and a 13-15 Years Girls Cricket State Championships. Each of these championships has a 'President's Team' which allows a pathway for students from a school sport region that does not have a regional team entered in the state championships. A number of girls from this session on Tuesday 8 March may be approached to fill positions in the respective president's team for the 2016 state championships.

Please check all the requirements on the attached flyer and we look forward to seeing on Tuesday 8 March 2016.
