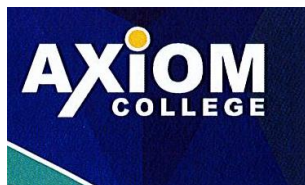

WHAT IS VETiS?

VETiS or Vocational Education and Training in Schools is 100% funded by the VET investment budget and is fee-free for students. The training is based upon work ready skills.

Talk to your school co-ordinator or head of senior schooling about the range of qualifications available.

- Delivered at school and available to year 11 and 12 students who are eligible for VETiS funding.
- Students have accessed VETiS funding if they are studying Tourism or Hospitality at school, courses through the trade training centre, TAFE or other external providers. (Early Childhood, Fitness, Business and IDMT are not VETiS funded courses)
- Trainers from Registered training Organisations will deliver the courses which are proposed to run one day per week for a semester.
- Courses will be run on student's timetabled day off – studying this qualification is in addition to normal school timetable.
- Minimum numbers for class sizes need to be met to enable the courses to be run.
- Courses to begin week 2, term 1 2017
- This is an opportunity to gain QCE points and complete a certificate qualification.
