

Representative School Sport Pathways

Beerwah State High School students have opportunities to participate in representative school sport beginning at a district level. It is important to note that Beerwah SHS falls into two different districts – Coastal District for all 13-19 year old sport as well as 12 year old swimming, cross country and athletics; and Glasshouse District for all remaining 12 year old sports. Students participate in the age group matching the age that they are turning this year. The notice below is a message about new processes for trialling for representative sport affiliated with Coastal District as well as direct-to-region sports.

Our school website will soon be updated to provide information relating to trial processes for both districts, as well links to district and regional websites and sport calendars.

The Sunshine Coastal School Sport Office, together with Coastal District School Sport, continues to offer a representative pathway for our students to attend district, regional, state and national school sport trials/championships.

In 2020, representative sport across the state is undergoing a number of changes. The major change in our region: Students and parents are responsible for checking dates of trials, submitting nominations and ensuring payments are made to compete at District, Regional, State and National Trials

A new online registration and payment process has been developed to assist parents and students in organising themselves for upcoming trial dates. The newly designed process streamlines paperwork for your child and yourself. The following information provides parents with a step-by-step process for 2020 trials.

DISTRICT TRIALS	
District trial dates and information will be advertised through your school's website, newsletter and social media (where appropriate) and on the Sunshine Coast School Sport website.	
Step 1	Students to collect a District Trial Information Pack from their school Sport Co-ordinator/PE Teacher.
Step 2	Parents/students go to Sunshine Coast School Sport Website and download the district trial notice.
Step 3	Parents go to School Shop Online and register to attend a trial. Schools will no longer be registering students to attend Coastal District Trials.
Step 4	Students must submit their completed Permission/Medical form and Mouthguard forms (if required) to the Coastal District official at the commencement of a trial. NO FORM & NO ONLINE REGISTRATION = NO TRIAL. Please note: If no online registration has been completed, this may limit your child's ability to fully trial.

DIRECT-TO-REGION TRIALS	
Direct-To-Region trial dates and information will be advertised through your school's website, newsletter and social media (where appropriate) and on the Sunshine Coast School Sport website.	

Step 1	Students to collect a Regional Trial Information Pack from their school Sport Co-ordinator/PE Teacher.
Step 2	Parents/students go to <i>Sunshine Coast School Sport Website</i> to register and pay online. This is a parent responsibility.
Step 3	Students must submit their completed paperwork (ie. Permission/Medical form and Mouthguard forms if required) to the Regional official at the commencement of a trial. NO FORM & NO ONLINE REGISTRATION = NO TRIAL.

PAYMENTS & LEVIES

Step 1	District & Regional Trial levies must now be paid through an online process
Step 2	Payment details will be outlined as follows: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Direct to Region Trials – payment outlined in registration documents collected from school sport co-ordinators. 2. District Team Representatives – payment will be outlined in the team selection letter.
Step 3	Orders and payment for district and regional apparel will be made online

Parents/students need to be aware of the changes outlined above. It is a parent/student responsibility to register online and complete the required payments etc. before attending a district or regional trial.
