2022 - BYOD Minimum Specifications Advice

Please take this document with you when purchasing a new laptop for use at Beerwah State High School.

Beerwah State High School recommends that all laptops used by students meet the minimum requirements below to ensure suitability for curriculum-based activities. The minimum specifications provided reflect the needs for connecting to business or corporate-grade Wi-Fi protocols.

Important Note: In order to connect your student's device to our network and install necessary software, they must have administrator access on the device.

Devices Accepted at School

- Laptops capable of running Windows 10 Home or better running the latest update.
- Apple Laptops running Mac OS 10.15+ Catalina or newer.

Devices Not Accepted at School

- Android devices are not compatible with our system.
- Windows 10 S is not compatible with our system.
- Linux is not supported, such as Google ChromeBooks.
- iPad mini is not supported.
- iPads and Tablet devices although some have found using an iPad as a laptop replacement works for them, we do not recommend them as a student's only device in the school environment. iPads are a great supplementary device but should not be viewed as a primary device.

When Purchasing your Device

- Parents can and should purchase from their preferred computer supplier. All warranty and service issues will be the parents' responsibility. Beerwah State High School is not involved in these arrangements, as these are personal devices.
- We strongly recommend that protection plans are purchased with all devices. Accidents do
 happen so having a warranty and accidental damage protection plan to cover the device for the
 duration of its life is advisable.
- We encourage families to consider future proofing your investment by considering the subjects chosen and the device requirements for these. For example, graphics programs or video editing software imposes higher demands on devices.

Beerwah State High School cannot tell you what to buy or who to buy your new device from, however we can offer general advice to parents.
