- You may be asked to finish products by drilling, deburring, polishing, etc
- You'll sometimes be asked to clean and tidy the factory working areas, or empty rubbish bins
- You may be responsible for lunchroom duties making sure there is milk in the fridge (bought from the lunch lady), cleaning up the lunchroom after lunch (see the To Do list in lunchroom), emptying bins in lunchroom & office (downstairs), etc
- You need to always be safety conscious
- You need to be able to work in a team or independently without constant supervision
- You need to always wear appropriate PPE & uniform as directed this includes keeping your shirt tucked in as this is a safety matter as well as being generally tidy
