From 1 July 2022, a new Australian Apprenticeships Incentive System will commence, aimed at securing skilled workers required to support Australia's economic recovery. With almost 80 occupations assessed as being in a national skills shortage, there is targeted support and incentives for both the employers and apprentices in these occupations. Here on the Sunshine Coast we currently have a plethora of advertised positions in this category, including:

bricklaying, cabinet making, carpentry and joinery, cookery, hairdressing, landscaping, plumbing, plastering, personal carers and telecommunications, to name a few.

Some apprenticeships require additional ticketing, such as a white card to legally enter a construction site, or perhaps a driver's licence. Link and Launch can connect you with service providers to gain these prerequisites, often subsidised or at no cost.
